Guided reading activities g g g ü the teacher chooses an appropriate text for the group. it should be slightly higher than the students' independent level and give them a few problems to solve. in advance, the teacher prepares a teaching point, discussion questions, and (sometimes) an extension. ü the teacher introduces the text. Guided reading . what is guided reading? •teacher works with a small group of students (4-6) who demonstrate similar reading behaviors and can all read similar levels of text •20-30 minutes •texts are teacher selected and easy enough for students to read with your skillful support.
