"inner workings" is j.m. coetzee's second collection of literary essays (my review of the outstanding first set, "stranger shores", can be found here), written between 2000 and 2005. coetzee again covers a wide spectrum of authors, ranging from some very well known to me, like gabriel garcia márquez, william faulkner, or günter grass, to ones whose names - due to my ignorance about world literature - i can barely recognize, for example walter benjamin or hugo claus."inner workings" represents a collection of j.m. coetzee's literary essays from 2000-2005. the majority, even those on important figures, are little more than book reviews or occasional work; they are almost never "critical" in either sense of the term.Inner workings is a series of 21 essays by the south african-born nobel prize winner j. m. coetzee. coetzee originally published sixteen of the essays in the new york review of books and four as introductions to texts.Inner workings is a collection of 21 essays by j.m. coetzee, 16 of which first appeared (in an earlier form) in the "new york review of books."Inner workings gathers 16 book reviews and four introductory essays written by coetzee between 2000 and 2005, a period that has seen him leave south africa, win the nobel prize for literature Coetzee's essays from 1986 to 1999, inner workings gathers together his literary essays from 2000 to 2005. coetzee further explores the work of six of twentieth-century german literature's greatest read more"inner workings" represents a collection of j.m. coetzee's literary essays from 2000-2005. the majority, even those on important figures, are little more than book reviews or occasional work; they are almost never "critical" in either sense of the term.
