Prague is a novel about sincerity and the lack of it in personal and historical nostalgia. phillips develops his characters artfully to illustrate deception in their dealings with each other and with key players in post cold war budapest. Prague is a novel whose title sets the tone for arthur phillips' wry style: the understimulated american/canadian expatriates at the centre of the book spend the year 1990 in budapest – despite the fact that everyone they meet is quick to tell them that prague is where things are really happening. Arthur phillips's bold and ambitious novel, prague, is one of those rare books that help define and identify a whole generation, in the same way that hemingway's the sun also rises introduced his lost generation.
