Problem/solution . explicit comprehension lesson . second grade . dole, 2004 . objectives: 1) raise cards at solution to problem—build museum. write on board. problem and then several attempts to solve the problem, with one final solution at the end. this is true for many stories and fairy tales. Lesson – problem solving and critical thinking learn: active practice 110-140 minutes purpose: the purpose of this activity is to have participants practice solving different types of problems. they will learn how to successfully go through each step in the problem solving process to reach a viable solution through a variety of activities. Comprehension readers lesson plan a (use for “a” lessons) every tutoring session 1. tutor read aloud (10 minutes)! select a read aloud book with your student. !what was the solution to the problem? after reading: # together: discuss the story structure. the tutor should write so the student can focus on content. A problem-solution project cross-curricular lesson ideas reading: • read trade books on citizenship, the life of martin luther king, jr., freedom, getting along with others, civil rights, women’s rights, the civil rights movement, etc. • read for literacy concepts emphasizing comprehension strategies such as compare/contrast, Guided reading lesson plan (levels m-z) title: hello, setting, characters, problem, solution... during reading: (10-15 min.) students silently read the text. you may choose to listen to a few students whisper read the text, if reading fluency is a concern. while students are silently reading, you can start another group or conference with
